You could link your celebration event to another day in the calendar, like International Women's Day (8th March) or Bonfire Night (5th November), when we celebrate the foiling of Guy Fawkes' attempt to blow up the King and the Houses of Parliament.

Ask learners to bring their favourite dish to share with others at your celebration event. You could get them to vote for the best dish at the end of the session!
